Read John 19:23-30

General Questions

- 1. What was this sermon about?
- 2. Is there anything in this text or something that the pastor said that stood out to you?

Main Idea: It is remarkable what Jesus endured on the cross in obedience to His Father

Sermon Points

- 1. Jesus finished His mission
- 2. Jesus finished Satan's hold on humanity
- 3. Jesus finished your salvation

Discussion Questions

- 1. Pastor Mike shared that Jesus' mission to save did not begin with His birth, but was revealed "in the beginning" (Genesis 3). What does that teach us about God's nature? About God's attitude toward man?
- 2. Jesus finished His mission. What is your God-given mission? What steps do you need to take to work to finish your mission?
- 3. Pastor Mike said that Satan had been at work attempting to prevent Jesus from finishing His mission to save the lost. Has the enemy ever been at work to prevent you from doing something God has called you to do? How did you (or can you) overcome Satan's attack on your God-given mission?
- 4. The Greek word translated to the english phrase "it is finished" is also used to describe a "debt being satisfied" or "paid in full". What debt did Jesus satisfy on the cross?
- 5. Read Luke 19:10. Discuss as a group why Jesus' death on the cross was necessary for Him to finish His mission to save the lost.
